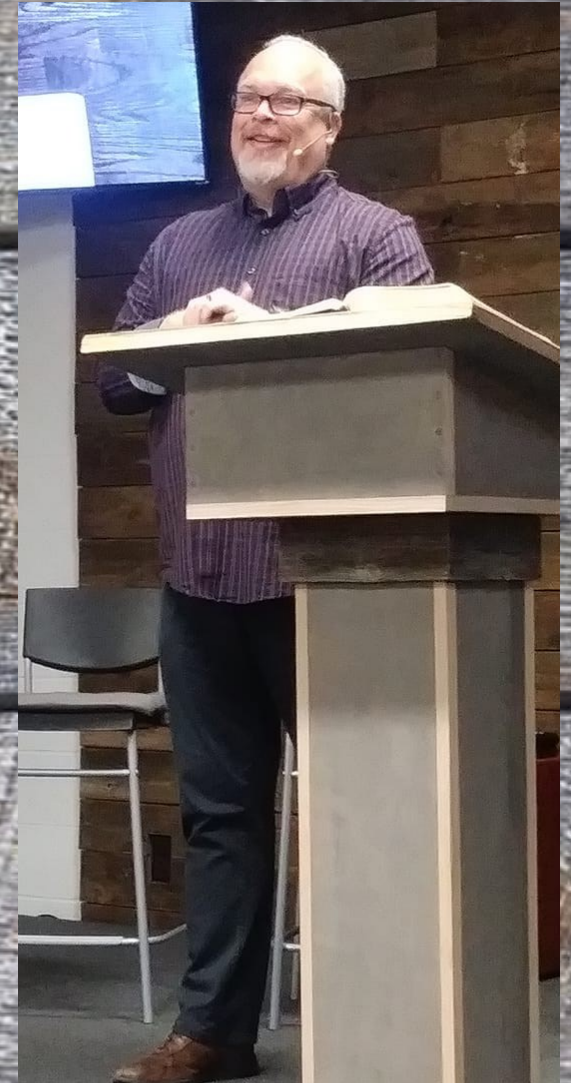

The Valley Baptist Church (VBC) started as a church-plant from the Lee's Summit Baptist Temple, on Sept. 7th, 2014 with a little over 20 people. Our first year we met in the Grain Valley Community Center and carried all of our equipment in and out of the building every week for church. After that first year, and through a series of unusual circumstances, we were able to lease and eventually purchase the vacant Mid-Continent Public Library building on Front St. in the heart of Grain Valley.



Through the years we have remodeled the interior of the building, adding walls and doors for classroom and auditorium space, updated the floors and lighting, and tried to stay up-to-date with our audio and video technology.

We've never closed our doors, though we saw the need and have offered livestreaming of our services since the pandemic.

VBC is a tough church to describe. People give all sorts of labels to churches, and make all sorts of assumptions about churches, based on their name. The B in VBC is for Baptist, and we hold that title proudly. Baptist churches have held tight to the gospel of Jesus for centuries, and we follow that theological tradition. From there, things get more dynamic. The church is laid-back and friendly, and no one gets too dressed up for church. Pastor Chris plays the drums for the worship team, but then preaches from a King James Bible. We've got bikers and construction workers, medical professionals, sales-people, clerks, techs, and an assortment of unique people that love Jesus, and want to spread his love. VBC is an unusual bunch of humans that you would never imagine doing life together, but God has made us a family, and we wouldn't have it any other way!

So what does our church believe?
